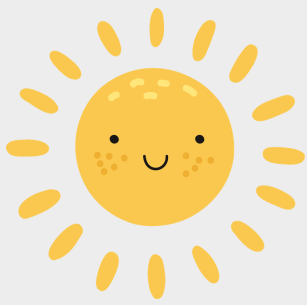






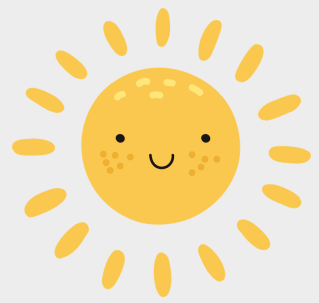

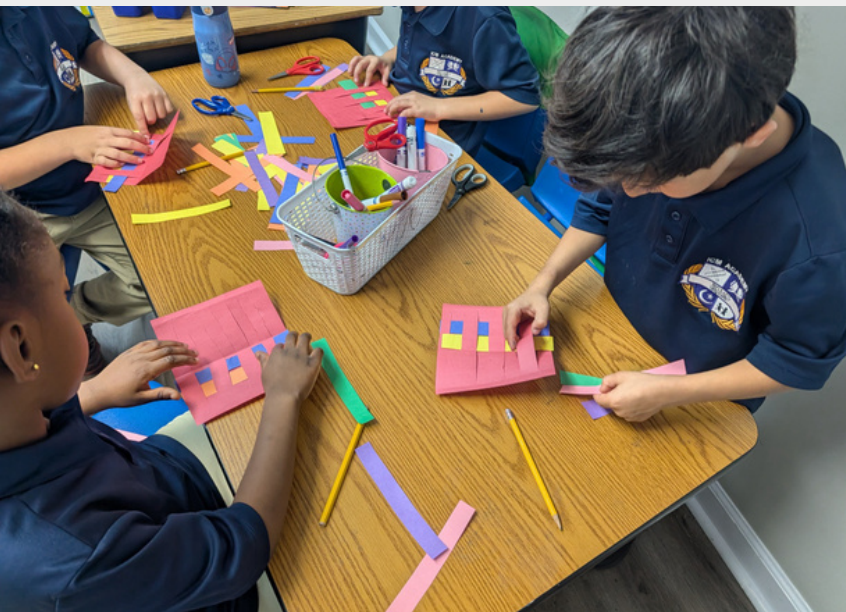
4TH GRADE STEM PROJECT
